

Born in Hong Kong in 1955, Mr. Claudio De Bedin came from a native Friulian family. His father, Umberto Maria Gaetano de Bedin, born in Milan in 1921, moved to China at the age of two. Since his grandfather moved to China at the end of XIX Century, the De Bedin Family is in China for three generations.

De Bedin started his studies at the Kowloon Junior School, and then studied at the King George V School. He graduated in Law from the University of Newcastle, England. In 1983 he started collaborating with an English firm. One year later his son, Gaetano, was born. Following in his father's footsteps, Gaetano studied law in Newcastle.

They both love Italy and they believe Italy is the most beautiful country in the world. On 1 January 2010 he started the de Bedin & Lee law firm, specialized in the assistance to European clients who wish to invest in the Chinese market.
